The City of Lake Charles and the Arts and Humanities Council of SWLA hosts the annual Holiday Art Market on **Friday, Dec. 8th** from **3:00PM – 7:00PM**, **Saturday, Dec. 9th** from **10:00AM-5:00PM**, and on **Sunday, Dec 10th** from **12:00PM-5:00PM**, in Central School.

For this festive event, the public is encouraged to buy local art as gifts for the holiday season. Small, affordable art and handmade items are preferred, though larger pieces are welcome.

Guidelines

- The fee is \$35/booth and at least 10% of sales, with funds to benefit MusicMakers2U.
- Customer transactions will be handled by each artist/booth.
- One-hour set-up time will be provided each day, and hallway booths will be relocated to a secure room each evening at close. Vendors are asked to park their vehicles across the street at First United Methodist Church after load-in, to save spaces for shoppers!
- **Vendors must provide their own tables**, no greater than 8' in length. Hallway space is narrow, so extra extension tables will only be acceptable for vendor booths in Room 108.
- Room 108 vendors will be chosen in consideration of those with fragile or heavy items that can't be easily moved to a locked room at closing.
- Submitting a completed application does not guarantee placement. Participating vendors will be contacted upon approval.

Space is VERY limited for this year's event.
