Kids, grades 4-8, both individual and/or teams— are invited to create a mural live in front of a street-side audience in only an hour. Student art war winners will be determined by Facebook voting! Spring Art Walk attendees will be encouraged to visit the Arts Council's Facebook page the following week to vote for their favorite student team.

## Student Art Wars 2019 | Guidelines

- I. Up to four student artists can be on a team, and the Art War is limited to the first ten team registrations. Individuals may compete by themselves. The team must work together within the allotted space and time to cooperatively create a single mural.
- 2. All materials, except for the foam core, must be supplied by the artists. Any mediums, any material, and any theme is accepted.
- 3. Each team will receive a sheet of foam core to create on. The size of the foam core is approximately 20"x30".
- 4. Unless advanced notification is given to the Arts Council, all finished murals will be in a silent auction during the Art Walk. 70% of the sales made off their mural will go to the child's school. Unsold murals become the property of the artist or team. All purchases of murals within the Art War must go through Arts Council staff.
- 5. Each team will begin work at 6 p.m. and will finish at 7 p.m. Each team's mural will be collected by Arts Council staff and volunteers, pending determination of the winner from voting on Facebook following the event.
- 6. Teams must sign in by 5 p.m. on April 26th to receive foam core sheet. Arts Council staff/volunteers will host a table near the corner of Ryan and Broad Street.
- 7. Winners will be determined through a Facebook vote on the Arts Council of SWLA page the following week, and the main contact listed below will be notified. The winning mural will be displayed at Central School, before being released to the team or auction buyer.
- 8. Team captain will later receive a check for 70% of silent auction sale, mailed to the address provided below.
